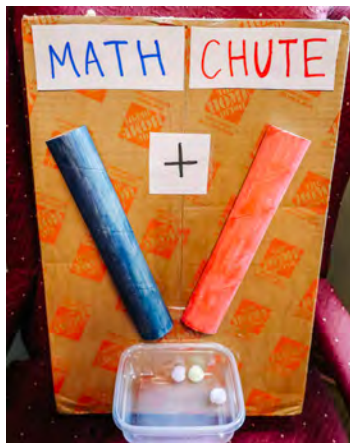
Math Chute

DOMAIN(S)

Math; Physical Development

MATERIALS

1. Cardboard box
2. Hot glue gun and glue sticks (For teacher use only)
3. Two paper towel rolls
4. One small plastic container (re-purpose a sandwich meat container)
5. Pom Poms (Or anything that can fit through the tube that you have multiples)



OBJECTIVES

1. Children will use colored pom poms or colored bears to compare quantities.
2. Children will use number words correctly.
3. Children will put pom poms or bears in the chute.

HEADS UP!

Once children have more experience with this game, your engagement style may change, and they may be able to work in small groups.



To make the the chute game

1. Hot glue two paper towel holders to a cardboard box or piece of cardboard at a slight angle, where they meet at the bottom.
-Color or paint one paper towel roll blue and the other roll red.
2. Hot glue a container to the cardboard underneath where they meet.
3. Draw a "+" in between the top of the paper towel rolls.



Small items can be a choking hazard.
